

OFFERFEST GIVING GOALS 2019 – text for tri-fold

- 1. Summer Mission Trip** **\$20,000**

Our hope is to bring 50-75 people (multi-generational) to serve alongside churches in the Salt Lake City, Utah area. The Salt Lake City County is estimated below 3% evangelical Christian. Our funds will help primarily with ministry-related expenses that the host churches will incur. We want to bless them by covering the majority of program cost so our mission will not over-burden our hosts. Funds raised will help us in pre-trip visits for planning & prayer with our host churches, administrative costs, training materials, and expenses related to mobilizing our leaders and team.
- 2. Church Internships/Leadership Development** **\$10,000**

We believe that in-house training and discipleship in ministry is one of the best ways to multiply leadership. Our hope is to provide the equivalence of (4) one-half scholarships for people interested in exploring ministry as a vocation, or for the “testing” of their calling. We will invite and train full-time summer interns to raise the other one-half of their salary through relational funding. We place a high value on training our own young adults, but are also interested in investing into other church members as God leads and to develop skills necessary for effective ministry. We believe that pre-planning and preparing to train leaders is part of our faith – believing that God will raise up people to invest into. We hope to become a church that is a “training center” for leadership in the future.
- 3. Life Journals & Life Groups** **\$6,000**

Beginning January 1, 2020, we are encouraging every church attendee to prayerfully consider participating in a one-year Bible reading, prayer, and journaling plan. Our pastors will be teaching and training people on an amazing way to interact with the scriptures as individuals, in small groups, and in our families. We desire to present every person in 2020 who makes First Baptist their home a Life Journal, and also the opportunity to learn how to participate in devotions as a group. Teens and adults will have age-appropriate journals as well as journals designed for younger children.
- 4. Community Christmas** **\$20,000**

In December, we will host our 2nd Community Christmas with the ice skating rink for our community. Our hope is to put on an incredible program for our community where we can share the love of Christ with our neighbors. Funds raised will allow us to concentrate on serving the thousands of people who will encounter the grace of God on our campus at Christmas. Our hope is to even grow as a church body as people respond to the gospel.
- 5. International Vision Trip** **\$18,000**

We believe God is inviting us to become even more invested into world mission in 2020. Our hope is to send a vision team each year to visit at least one missionary that we support. We hope to provide: loving care for the entire family & ministry team, prayer support, to be attentive and listen to current needs and victories, and to increase our level of partnership. There is no substitute for being present with our missionaries in trenches of ministry. This team will also discern if a future short-term team from FBC is desired to aid our missionaries in their mission and what time frame works best for them. Our FBC “Go Team” will be involved in helping call out a team to join this vision team in 2020.
