

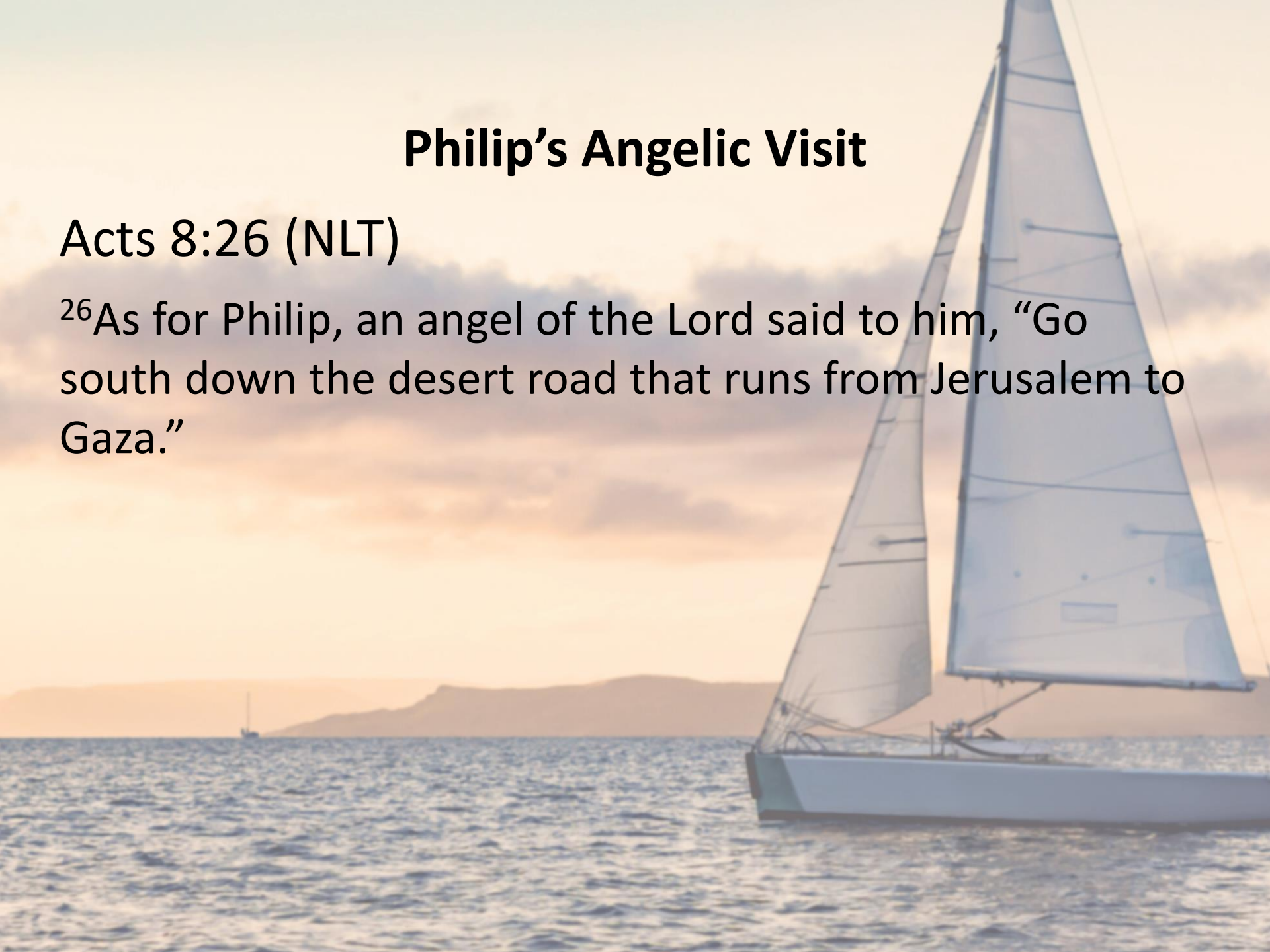

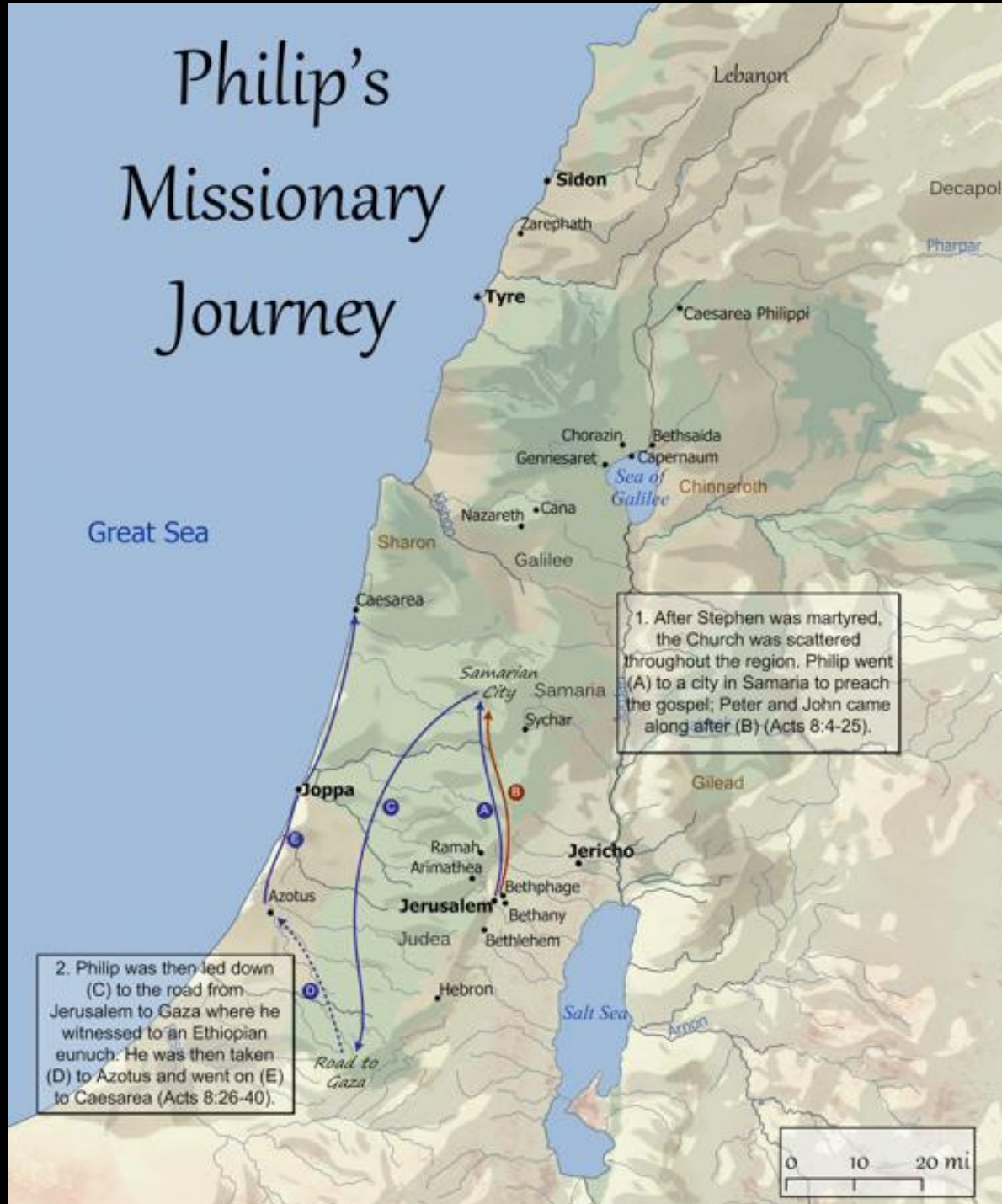
## Philip's Angelic Visit

Acts 8:29 (NLT)

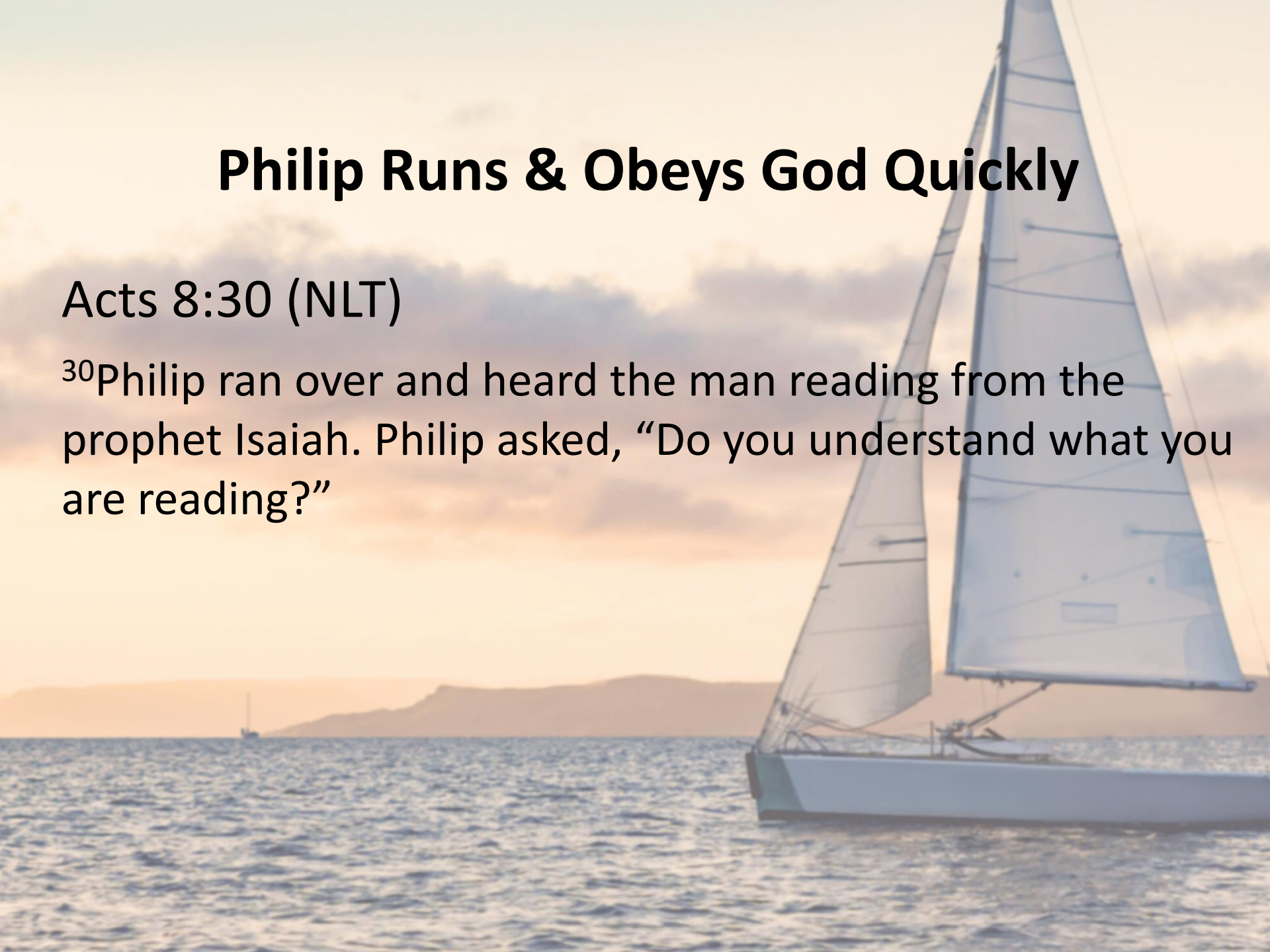
<sup>29</sup>The Holy Spirit said to Philip, “Go over and walk along beside the carriage.”

<sup>33</sup>He was humiliated and received no justice. Who can speak of his descendants? For his life was taken from the earth.”

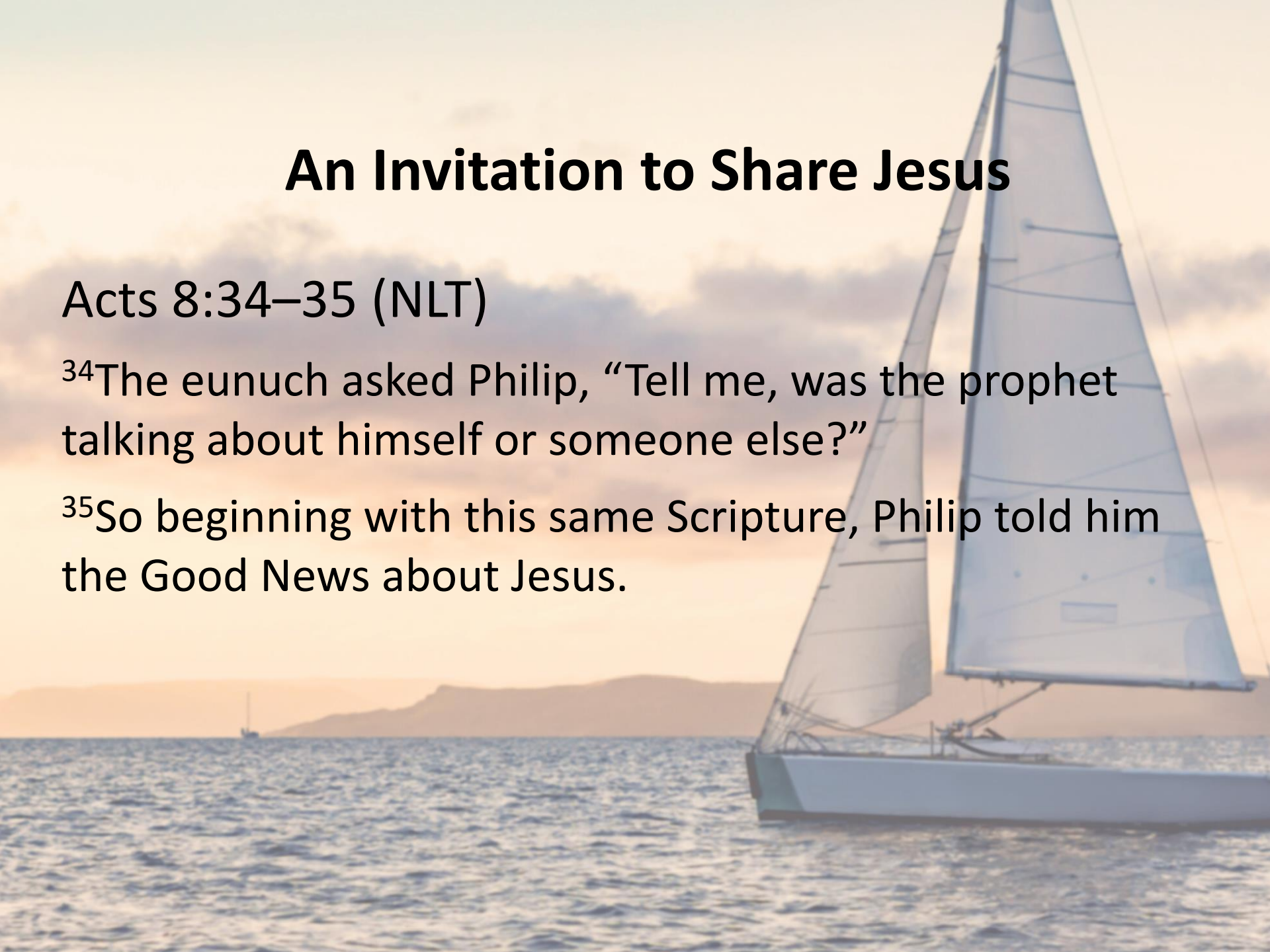


# An Invitation to Share Jesus

<sup>35</sup>So beginning with this same Scripture, Philip told him the Good News about Jesus.

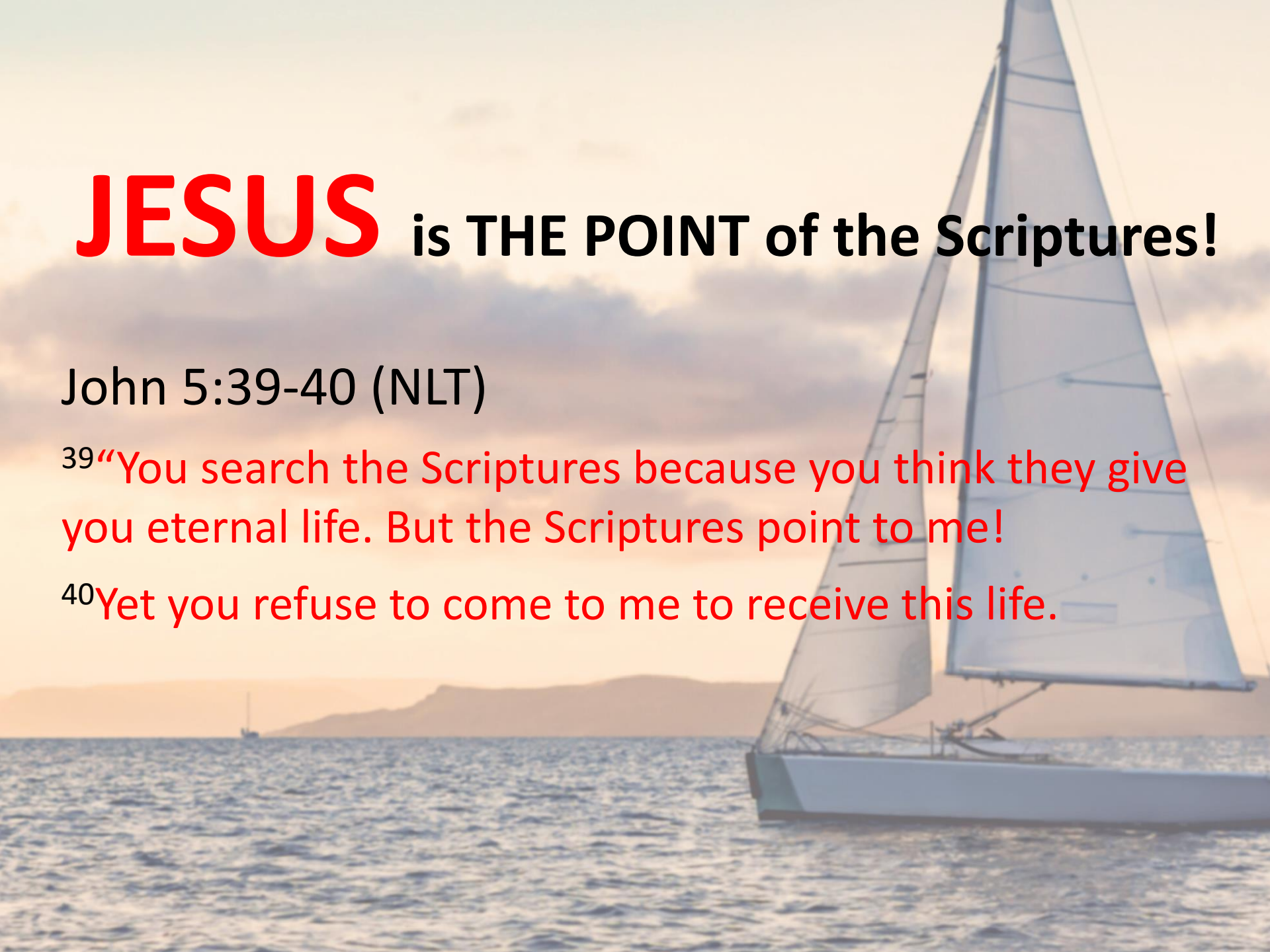


# **JESUS** is **THE POINT** of the **Scriptures!**

<sup>40</sup>Yet you refuse to come to me to receive this life.

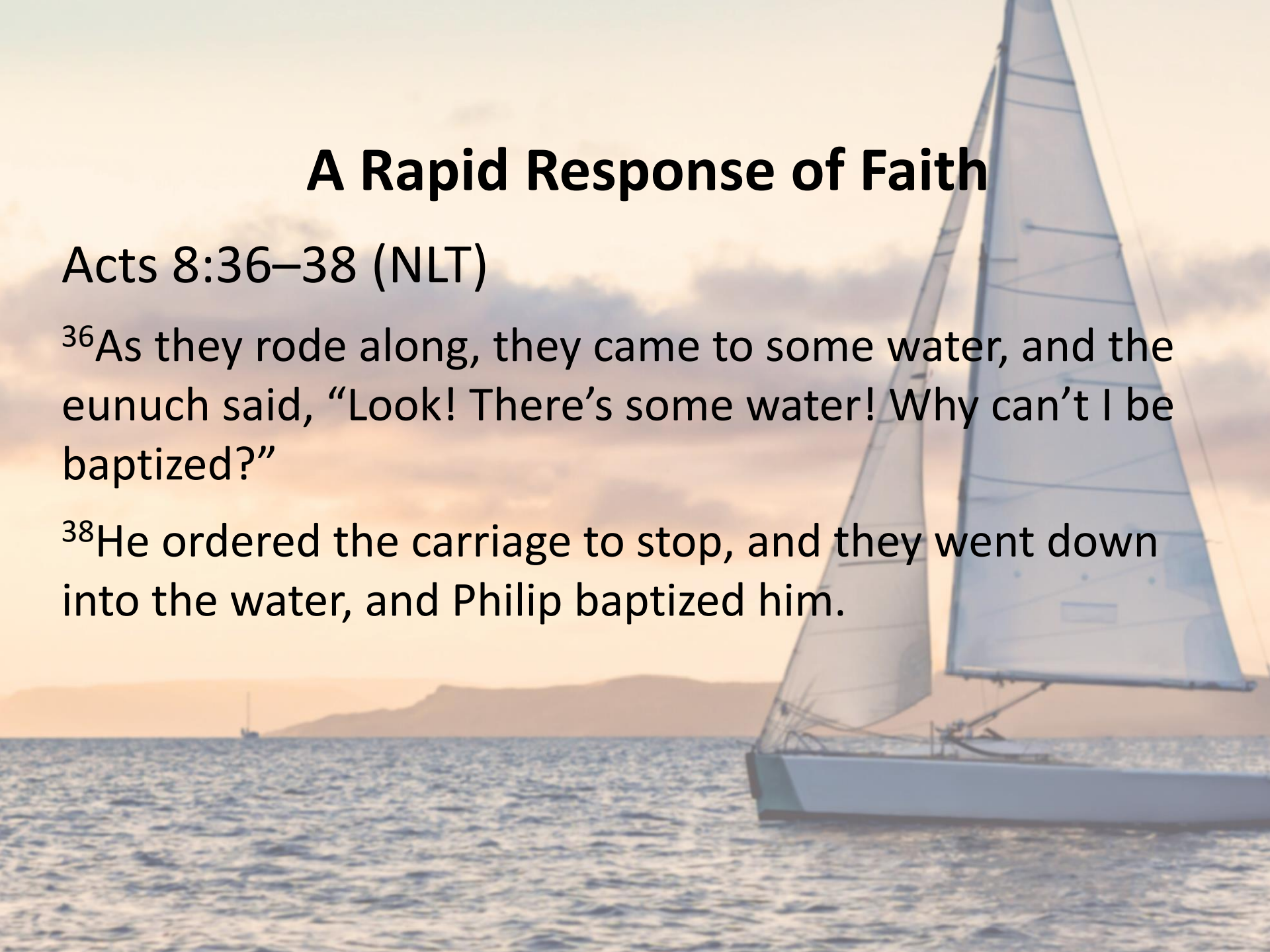


# A Rapid Response of Faith

<sup>38</sup>He ordered the carriage to stop, and they went down into the water, and Philip baptized him.

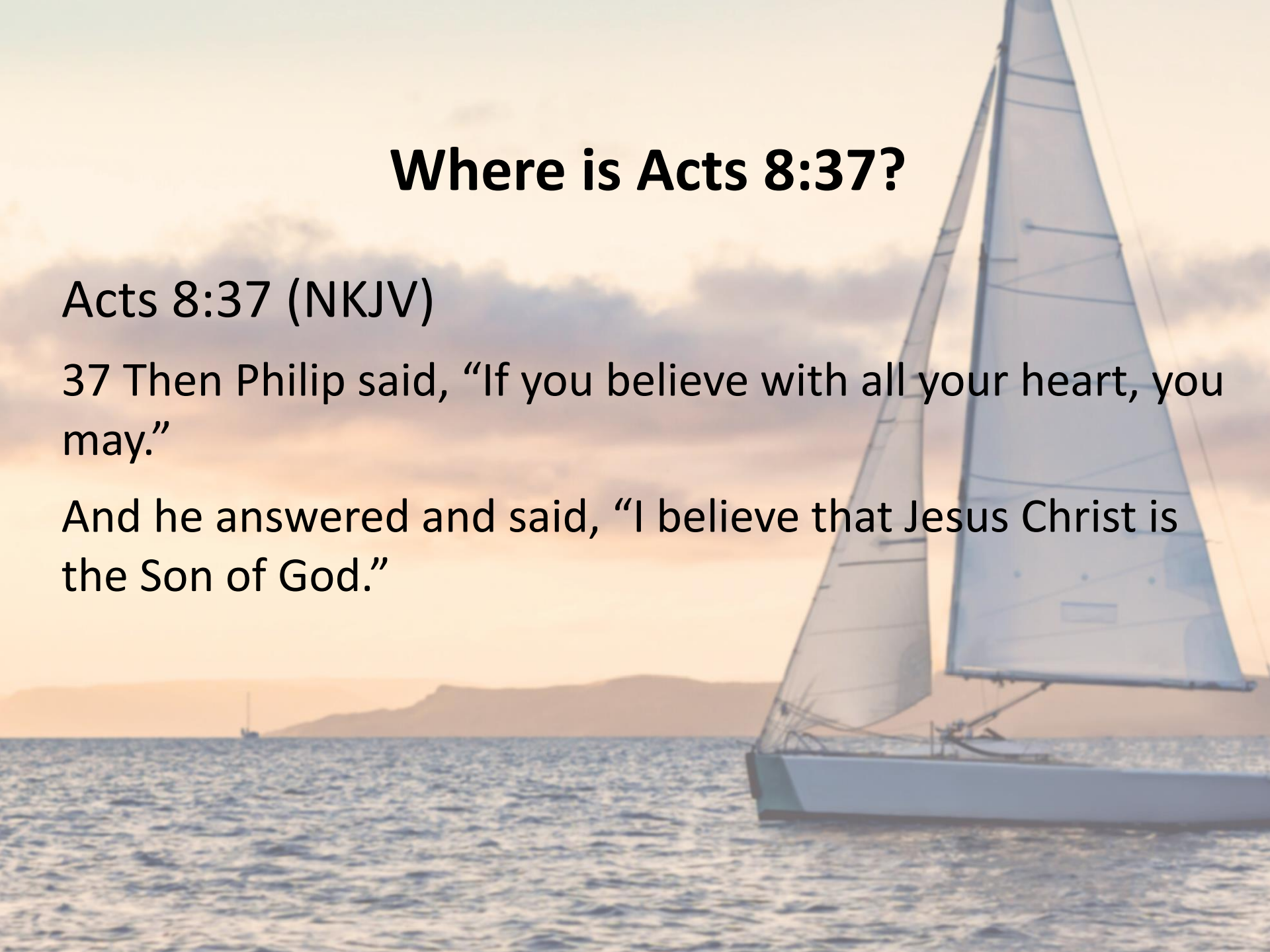


# Where is Acts 8:37?

And he answered and said, “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.”

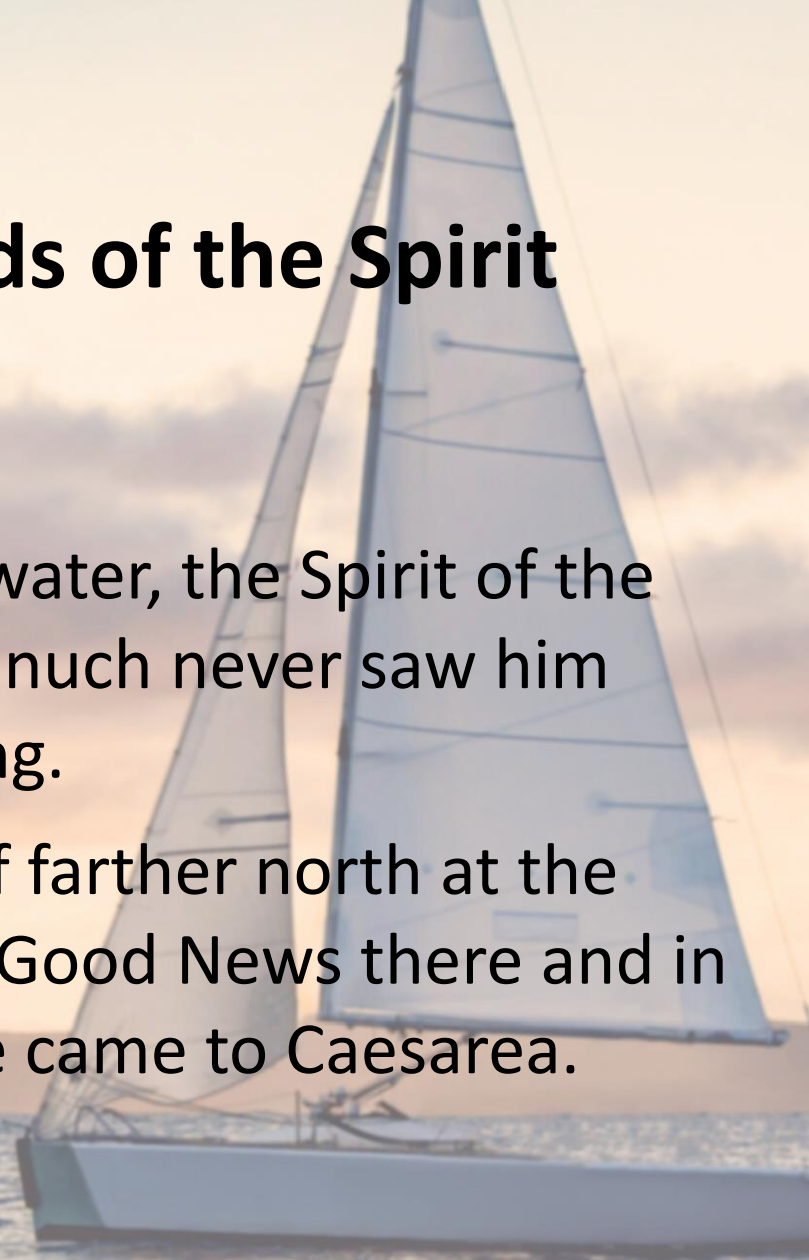


# The Mysterious Winds of the Spirit

Acts 8:39-40 (NLT)

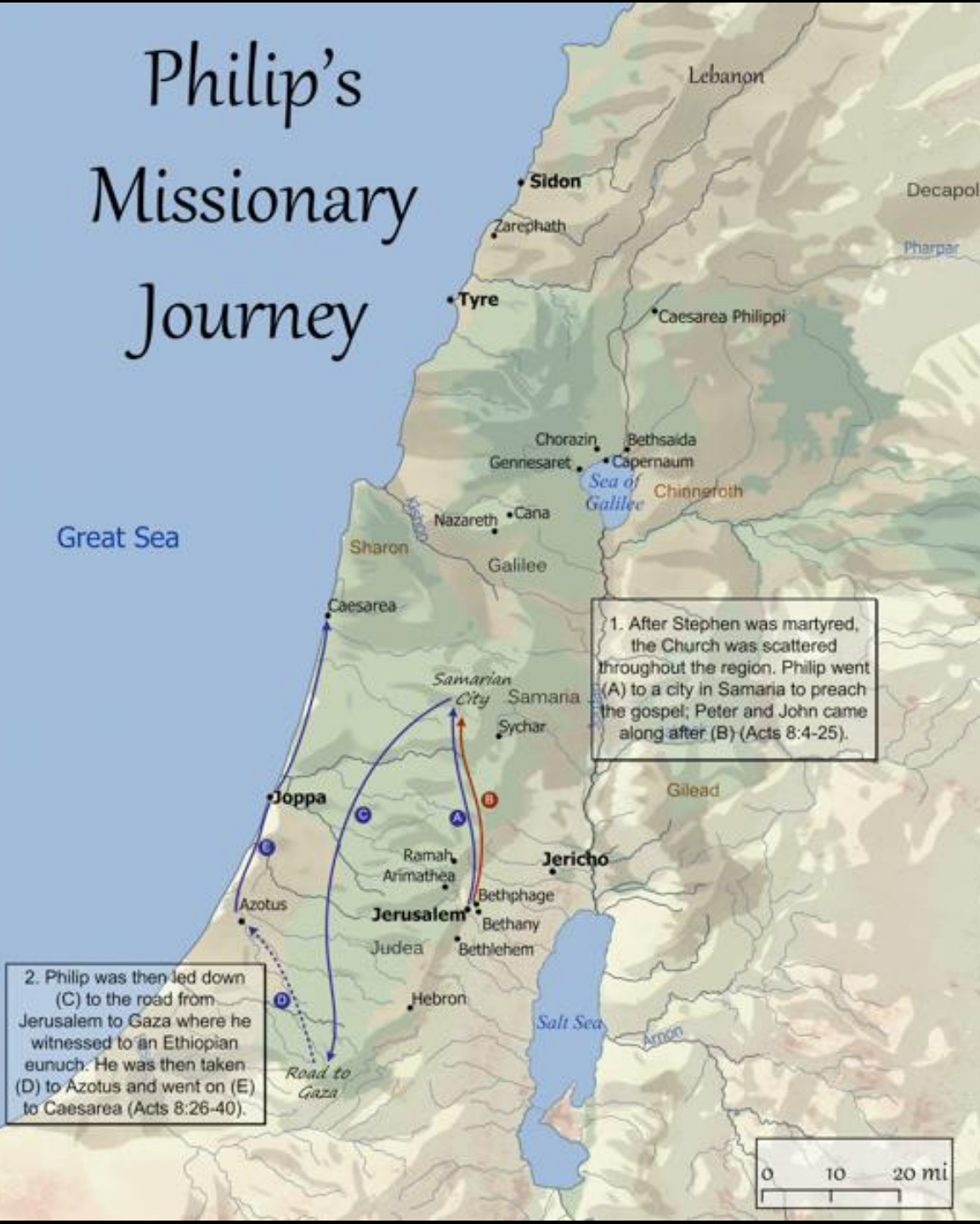
<sup>39</sup>When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord snatched Philip away. The eunuch never saw him again but went on his way rejoicing.

<sup>40</sup>Meanwhile, Philip found himself farther north at the town of Azotus. He preached the Good News there and in every town along the way until he came to Caesarea.



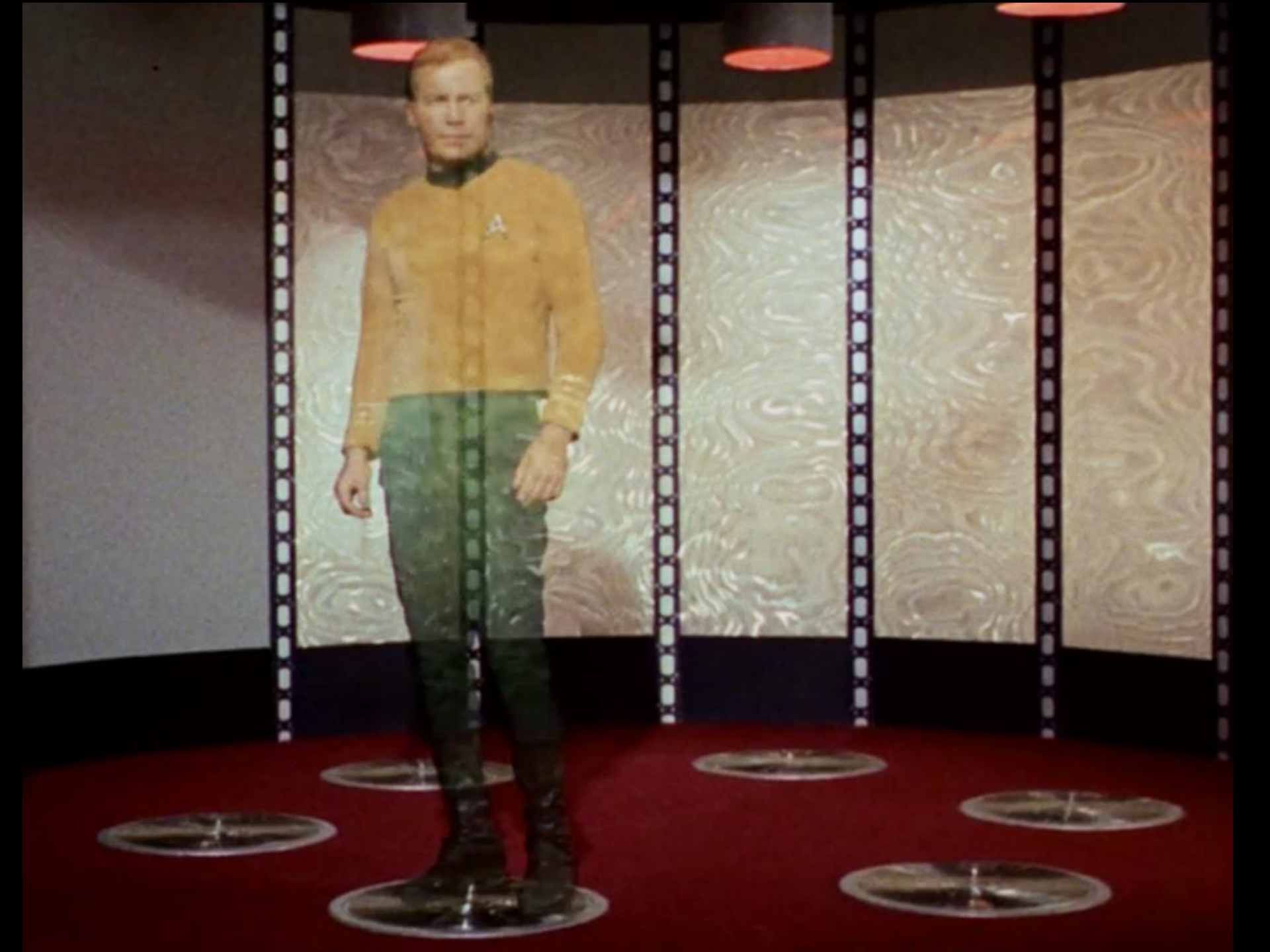
# Philip's Missionary Journey

Great Sea



1. After Stephen was martyred, the Church was scattered throughout the region. Philip went (A) to a city in Samaria to preach the gospel; Peter and John came along after (B) (Acts 8:4-25).

2. Philip was then led down (C) to the road from Jerusalem to Gaza where he witnessed to an Ethiopian eunuch. He was then taken (D) to Azotus and went on (E) to Caesarea (Acts 8:26-40).
